SAFETY CATEGORY

The requirements of <u>Category 4</u> of World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations 2018 are recommended for this race. Details of these are on the ISORA website.

THE DECISION WITH REGARD TO STARTING AND CONTINUING A RACE LIES ABSOLUTELY WITH THE SKIPPER OF EACH BOAT AS HE / SHE ALONE IS AT ALL TIMES RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF HIS / HER OWN BOAT AND CREW

TIME OF START FOR ALL CLASSES

- 10.55 Warning signal Class flags (Numerals 1 & 2) hoisted
- 10.56 Preparatory Signal Blue Peter hoisted
- 10.59 Blue Peter down
- 11.00 Start Class flags down

The start may be broadcast on VHF Channel 37 (M1)

YB TRACKERS

YB Trackers will **NOT** be used in this race

CLASS SPLIT

Class 0 - > 1.034 Class 1 1.000 - 1.034 Class 2 <1.000

STARTING LINE

The start line shall be located in Scotsman's Bay between the DBSC 'Pier' mark and an adjacent committee boat flying a NYC burgee. It may not be anchored and may be using engine power to hold station. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

THE COURSE (21 miles)

Start – Dun Laoghaire South Burford (P) Rosbeg East (P) Killiney Outfall (P) South Burford (P) Finish – Dun Laoghaire

The course is approximately 21 mile long. The course will be posted on the ISORA website, texted and emailed to all entries by Friday 13th April. The course shall be broadcast on VHF Channel 37 (M1) before the start.

FINISH LINE

The finish line shall be between the Pier Ends at the Dun Laoghaire Harbour entrance.

When approximately 10 minutes from the finish line yachts shall advise of their approach on **VHF Ch 37 (M)** call sign 'ISORA Finish'. Please note that the finisher will only have a handheld radio and you may not receive an acknowledgment. There will be no sound signal at the finish. The Finisher may radio confirmation of the finish.

The finish time of your boat and the name of the boat ahead and behind shall be recorded. Also the time of rounding each mark should be recorded in the log by each boat. The time of the finish or, in the case of a retirement, the time of rounding the last mark shall be text to **ISORA** at **+353 87 2545037** as soon as possible after the race.

The above procedure is mandatory and deemed to be a "Declaration" that the yacht has completed the course in accordance with the sailing instructions.

The time limit for this ISORA race is 16.00 on 14th April 2018. The finisher may not be in attendance at the finish line for later finishers.

RETIREMENTS

Text ISORA on 00353 87 2545037. For safety it is recommended to also inform the Coastguard by VHF.

PRIZEGIVING

Prizes will be awarded for the winner in each IOR class. Second and third place for classes with 5 or 7 boats in the class. The prizes will be awarded in NYC at 17.00 after the race. Prize winners must be present at the prizegiving to collect the prize.

Prizes will be bottles of Jack Ryan award winning 12 year old single malt Irish whiskey.
